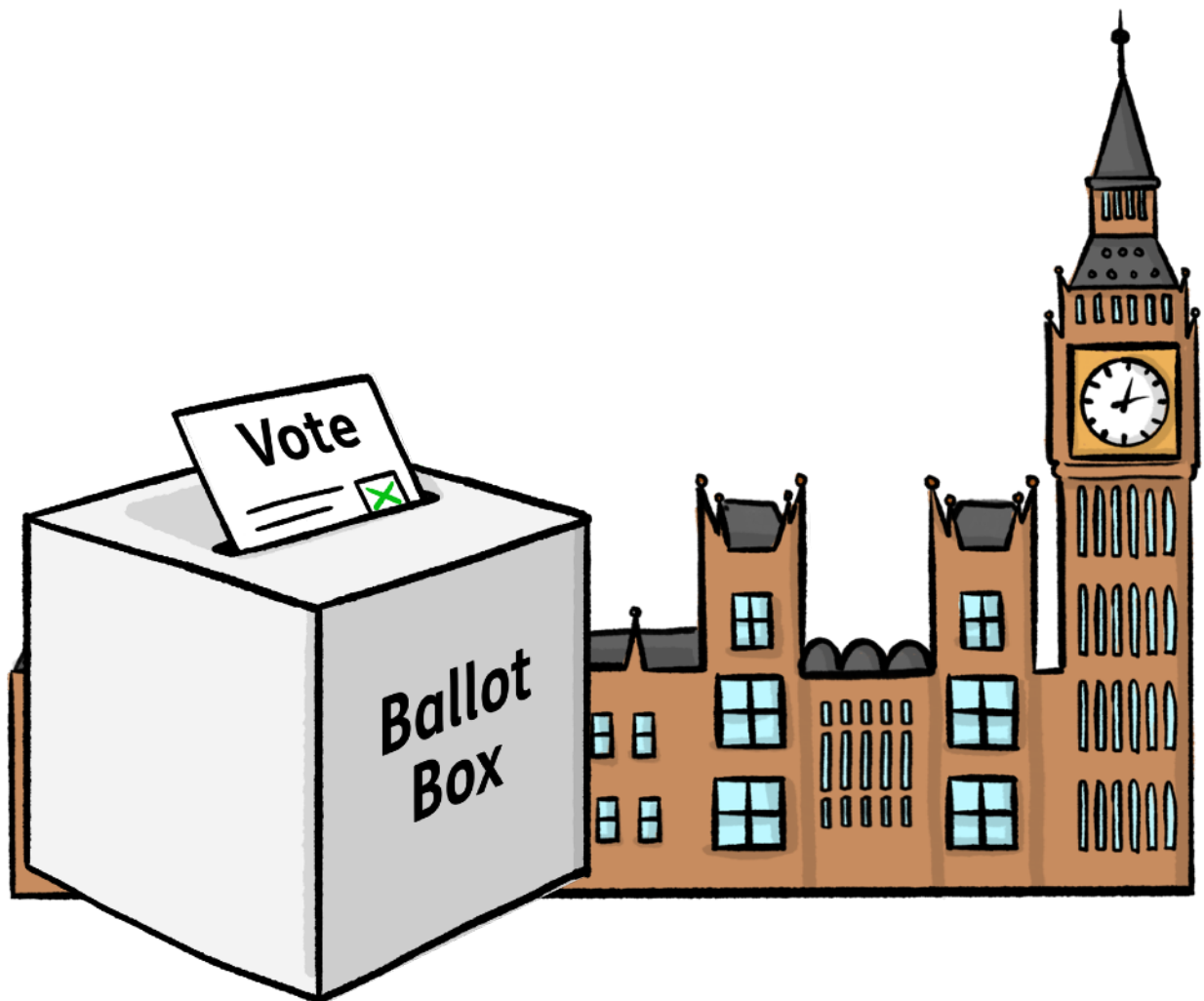

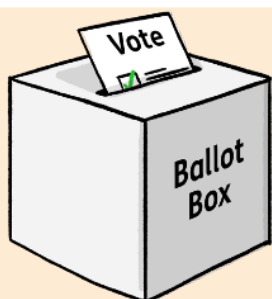

About the General Election



There is going to be a **General Election** in the UK on Thursday, 4 July 2024.



A **General Election** is when everyone can vote for their **Member of Parliament (MP)**.



Members of Parliament (MPs) make laws and decisions for the United Kingdom.



Everyone over 18 has the right to have their voice heard by voting in a General Election, including people with learning disabilities.



If you cannot go and vote, you can vote by post or ask someone else to vote for you.
